Dothan Area Homeschoolers currently seeking teachers to teach homeschool co-op classes on Fridays from August to November for the Fall 2018-2019 semester, and again in January to April for the Spring 2018-2019 semester.

This will be a new homeschool co-op serving area homeschool families throughout the Wiregrass Area. While it

will be a traditional homeschool co-op with many of the classes parent -teacher led, we are in need of additional teachers for both lead teaching positions and assistant teaching positions to be

able to fill all of our class matrix.

Teaching within the homeschool co-op primarily volunteer a position. However, some classes will have a fee assigned by the teacher to cover his/her time and services as well as an expense fee.

If you are a retired teacher, or an adult with any type of trade or expertise, craft or knowledge base that you could teach homeschoolers, and are willing to teach one or more classes, please visit http://

Classes will take place at First Free Will Baptist Church in Dothan, Alabama, on Fridays from 9am to 2pm in one hour blocks. Teachers do not have to teach all four blocks. Teachers can teach one hour or multiple hours.

Some suggested classes include: sewing,

crafting, photography, creative writing, reading help, math (all levels), science (all levels), STEM, robotics, Bible, art, music/ band, sign language, foreign language, sports, physical education, cooking, cake

decorating, voice, computer, etc.

All teachers will be asked to submit to a background check and drug test. All classes must be taught from a Christian viewpoint and prospective. curriculum used in the classrooms must be approved by the co-op leadership.
